

The AI Labor Shift: Sector Displacement vs. Emerging Opportunities

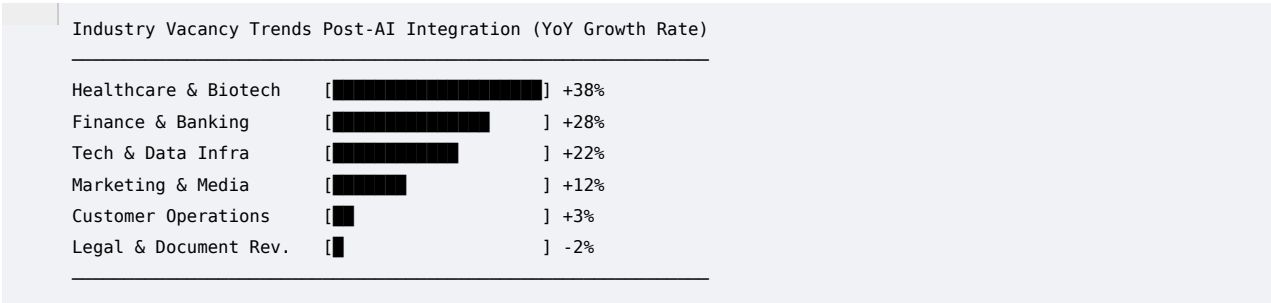

1. Shift in Job Vacancy Growth Across Key Sectors

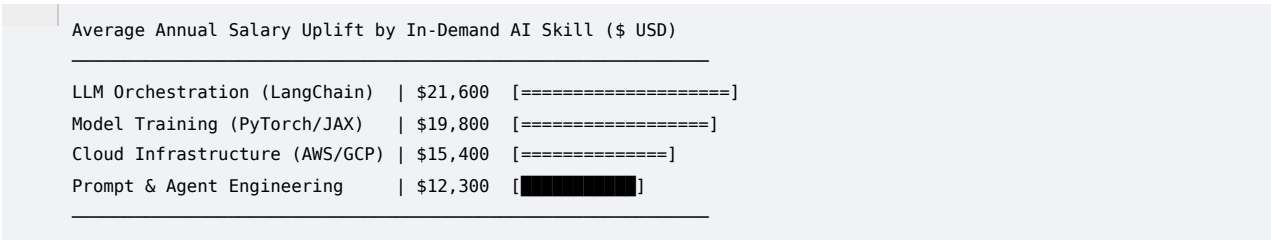
- Healthcare & Life Sciences:** Rapid growth in vacancies (+35% to +40%) driven by AI medical imaging, drug discovery, and diagnostic automation.
